## **INTRO QUESTIONS:**

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Have you ever known someone who had a real life child run away like the prodigal son? What did you learn about the heart of a father or mother from seeing them go through that?
- Which brother from the parable of the lost son do you think you're more like? Why?

### **KEY PASSAGES:**

- **Ephesians 2:8-10** How does this passage affect how you view others who are actively far from God?
- 1 Corinthians 5:9-13 How well do you think you apply this difference in how you deal with believers and unbelievers?
- **Matthew 7:1-6** How do you think these verses are misunderstood or misused? How would you simplify Jesus' commands here in your own words?

# **GROUP DISCUSSION:**

- Are there "prodigals" in your life that you've had a wrong attitude towards? What could you do this week to rectify that?
- How welcome do you think a person far from God would feel walking into our church? Is there something our group could do to improve that?
- Have you ever been the prodigal? Tell us about what brought you back to God.
- How do you balance love and grace with a desire to challenge people and help them live lives of holiness?
