INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Who is the most impressive person you've ever encountered?
- When have you seen someone you wouldn't have expected be impressive?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **Hebrews 11:1** How would you define faith in your own words?
- **Hebrews 11:6** What does this verse make you feel?
- **James 2:14-20** How do you explain the relationship between faith and doing good deeds? How does this relate to pleasing God?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- What do you think it is about human nature that wants to be impressive?
- Have you ever tried to impress someone and absolutely failed? If you're willing, tell us about it.
- Why do we still desire to impress God, even though we know there's nothing we can do to earn His love?
- Who are some of today's "outsiders," and how can we be more welcoming to them in this church (or group)?
