INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Who was one of your biggest childhood heroes and why?
- Who is the most famous or important person you've had the opportunity to meet?
- Which celebrity would you like to meet?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **Philippians 2:8-11** In light of this week's essay, does anything in this familiar passage impact you differently?
- **2 Peter 1:16-18** What does this reminder that Peter was an eyewitness to Jesus' divinity do for your confidence in the accuracy of the Bible?
- **Revelation 19:11-16** How does this apocalyptic picture of Jesus compare with how you typically picture Him?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- In what ways do we tend to make Jesus too small or less divine than He really is?
- What are some of the other opinions of who Jesus really is that you've heard from people?
- Have you ever tried to explain the true divinity of Jesus to someone who didn't believe? How did that conversation go?
- What could you do this week to better worship Jesus as God incarnate?

WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 111, we were given a pretty convicting challenge to align our devotion to Jesus with our confession of Him and ask for some accountability in that area. Don't share more than you're comfortable sharing, but how has that been going this week?
