# **INTRO QUESTIONS:**

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Who is the best neighbor you ever had? Any horror stories of your worst neighbor?
- Before this week's reading, how would you have answered the question, "How can I be sure I'm saved?"

### **KEY PASSAGES:**

- 1 John 4:20-21 Does these verses give you encouragement or conviction? Why?
- **Matthew 5:43-48** Do you have someone you consider an "enemy" in your life? How can you show them more love this week?
- **Galatians 5:13-14** How can you better use your freedom in Christ to serve someone else in love?

# **GROUP DISCUSSION:**

- How would you rate yourself on the "Good Samaritan" scale? Are you neighborly to everyone you encounter?
- How does our love for others reveal that we are saved? Can you be saved without showing love to those around you? Why or why not?
- How do you balance God's free gift of salvation with the evidence of love for others we should see in our lives?
- Who is a "neighbor" in your life you have a difficult time loving? What could you do this week to show more love to them?
