INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- How would you describe Jesus' political agenda in our modern context?
- What is something in our world that you care deeply about that you believe Jesus also cares deeply about?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **Ephesians 2:19-22** Based on this passage, what kind of unity do you think we should see in the Church? How close do you think we are to achieving that?
- 1 Corinthians 3:16-17 Based on how passionate God is about His new temple (the Church), what should we do differently to build better unity in the Church?
- **Jeremiah 7:1-11** What words or concepts jump out at you as things God is particularly passionate about?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- How do you understand Jesus' cursing of the fig tree before this chapter? What do you think about it now?
- Jesus clearing the Temple is often used as an example of righteous anger. When have you experienced that same kind of righteous anger? How can we know if our anger is truly "righteous" or not?
- In what ways have you seen the Church destroy itself? Going back to 1 Corinthians 3:16-17, why should we resist the urge to minimize the importance of that?
- What is something you think would be on Jesus' political agenda for today that you can do something about?

WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 269, we were challenged to develop an action plan for carrying out one thing that would be on Jesus' political agenda. Who is willing to share their plan?
